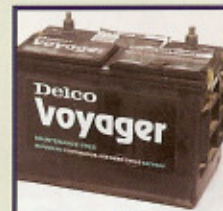

# SOCRRA CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES



Cardboard:  
See guidelines  
below.



Household  
Batteries: Place  
in clear baggies.



Empty metal cans and small  
scrap metal items.



Glass Bottles:  
Clear and brown only.



Paper, paperback books, mail, newspapers, magazines & paperboard boxes: Mix together in paper or plastic grocery bag; no hard cover books.



All plastic containers that fit in your bin;  
Discard hard plastic caps.

## Household Hazardous Waste



Residents (sorry, no businesses) may make an appointment to bring their toner & ink jet cartridges, paints, solvents, garden chemicals, household cleaners, insulin syringes, fluorescent light bulbs, oils, and other household hazardous waste from homes, NOT businesses.

## Electronic Equipment Don't Trash That Technology!



Recycle your old electronic equipment! Residents (sorry, no businesses) can make an appointment to bring their old electronic equipment for recycling. SOCRRA accepts computer monitors, CPUs, printers, TVs, radios, telephones, cell phones, copy machines, fax machines, stereos, VCRs & CD players.

## More Metal Recycling

Need to recycle **large metal items**?

Place items such as grills, bikes, lawn mowers, washers, dryers and water heaters next to recycle bin for collection at the curb.

## Easier Cardboard Preparation!

Please prepare your cardboard boxes in one of the following ways:

- 1 Unfold, flatten and bundle boxes with twine or tape and place inside, next to or under bin.



- 2 Unfold, flatten and stuff smaller boxes into larger box (no larger than 18"Wx24"Lx24"H) along with other fiber items and place inside or next to bin.

- 3 Set empty, large appliance boxes next to recycling bin. Make sure they are clear of packing materials or other trash. No need to break them down!
